

Appendix 5: Administrative provisions

Clause 6.2 of the Agreement Personal data

If the Customer approves the processing of personal data by the Supplier's subcontractor (s), the names of the subcontractor (s) must be stated here.

Clause 11.2 of the Agreement Pay and working conditions

This agreement is covered by regulation 8 February 2008 no. 112 on wages and working conditions in public contracts. The supplier has, in connection with signing this agreement, delivered a signed declaration for occupational crime. The following applies to the contract:

A. In general

In areas covered by regulations on generalized collective agreements, the supplier must ensure that own and any subcontractors' employees who directly contribute to fulfilling

The supplier's obligations under this agreement do not have worse pay and working conditions than what follows from the regulations that generalize the collective agreement. In areas that are not covered by a general collective agreement, the Supplier must ensure that the same employees do not have worse pay and working conditions than what follows from the current nationwide collective agreement for the industry in question. This applies to work carried out in Norway.

All agreements entered into by the Supplier, which involve the performance of work as direct contributors to fulfilling the Supplier's obligations under this agreement, shall contain corresponding conditions.

B. Non-fulfillment

If the Supplier does not fulfill this obligation, the Customer has the right to withhold part of it the remuneration for the Supplier's services, corresponding to approx. 2 (two) times the savings for The supplier, until it is documented that the relationship has been put in order.

Fulfillment of the Supplier's obligations as mentioned above must be documented in self-declaration or a third-party declaration that there is agreement between the relevant collective agreement and actual pay and working conditions for fulfillment of the Supplier's and any subcontractors' obligations.

C. Documentation

The supplier must, at the request of the customer, provide documentation about the salary and working conditions that are used. The customer and the supplier can each demand that the information must be presented to an independent third party commissioned by the Customer examine whether the requirements of this provision have been met. The supplier

can demand that the third party must have signed a declaration that the information will not be used for purposes other than ensuring fulfillment of the Supplier's obligations hereunder the provision. The documentation obligation also applies to subcontractors.
